

**Title:**

General Conference Singing Time: Match the Message Song Hunt

## Objective

Help children connect Primary songs to gospel messages taught during General Conference while actively participating in singing time.

## Materials Needed

- Printed **Message Clue Cards** (7–8 total)
  - Printed **Song Title Cards**
  - Tape (to hide song titles around the room)
  - Device with songs queued and ready to play
  - Optional: small basket or envelope for clue cards

## Songs Included

- I Will Walk With Jesus
  - Tell Me the Stories of Jesus
  - Love One Another
  - Have I Done Any Good in the World
  - He Is Risen
  - The Iron Rod
  - We Thank Thee, O God, for a Prophet
  - Gethsemane
- 

## Setup (Before Primary)

1. Print and cut out all **Song Title Cards**
2. Hide each song title around the room (examples):
  - Under a chair
  - Behind the piano
  - On the board
  - Near the door
  - Under a table
3. Keep **Message Clue Cards** with you at the front

## Activity Instructions

### Step 1: Introduce the Activity

Say something like:

“Today we’re going to do a *General Conference Song Hunt!* I’m going to read a clue about a message, and your job is to find the song in the room that matches that message.”

### Step 2: Play the Game

1. Invite a reverent child (or small group) to come up
2. Read one **Message Clue Card** aloud
3. Let them search for the matching song title
4. Once found, bring it to the front
5. Briefly connect the message to the song
6. Sing along with the music - you can either have the pianist play or play the General Conference song. Here are the links to the songs I specifically made for these clues.

Repeat until all songs are found

### Step 3: Add a Teaching Moment (Optional but Recommended)

After each song, ask one quick question:

- “What did this song teach us?”
- “How does this help us during General Conference?”
- “When can we live this this week?”

## Wrap-Up

Say something like:

“Just like we searched for songs today, we can listen carefully during General Conference to find messages that are meant just for us.”
